

Charlottetown Harbour Authority Inc.
Harbour Fee
Effective April 1, 2012

1. The charge payable for each entry of a vessel entering the Port of Charlottetown, per gross registered tonne is, in the case of a vessel:

(a) used in the carriage of goods or passengers from a place in Canada to another place in Canada at the time it comes into the Port Charlottetown, which is

\$0.03

- (i) registered in Canada, or
- (ii) under the Coasting Trade License issued pursuant to the Coasting Trade Act

(b) other than a vessel referred to in paragraphs (a) (i) or (ii).

\$0.05

2. The charge for a self - propelled vessel that ordinarily operates only within the limits of the Port of Charlottetown and that engages in commercial activity therein is, where the vessel is:

(a) less than 100 GRT, payable once in each calendar year

\$85.00

(b) 100 GRT to 200 GRT, payable once in each calendar year

\$165.00

(c) greater than 200 GRT, payable once in each calendar year

\$325.00
